

8@8 Pistol Comp

- BFTO run pistol competition starting in January which is internal to the BFTO(January and February's cards can be shot together)
- The key features of the 8@8 competition is as follows:
- All pistols must be under 6ftlbs, and be able to be shot both single and double handed. (no stocks etc to be used) any calibre can be used.
- The 8@8 competition uses score cards put out at 8 yards.

- There are two different categories in each competition – open sights and optical sights (including scopes, red dots reflex sights etc)
- No lasers to be used
- Target cards are issued to each shooter entered in the competition individually.

- Each pellet scores in the zone it pierces the target, if it breaks a line the higher score is awarded
- Each card has 2 targets on it – 8 shots are taken at each target disk. The left hand target is one handed the right hand is 2 handed
- all shots to be taken freehand, not supported in anyway
- All shots are to be taken standing, any registered disabled shooters may take their shots sitting if this is more appropriate
- After each shot the muzzle of the pistol must touch the bench

- Only one card can be shot each month for the duration of the competition.

- Cards are scored out of 80
- Each card is scored by yourself and witness then posted in folder on pistol board
- The competition will run from January 2012 until December 2012.
- Cards can be shot at any time a long as they are witnessed.

- The best 7 scores for each shooter are taken and used as the final standings at the end of the year.
